DEAR TAXPAYER:

This is an informational letter concerning the new Pike County Occupational License Fee Tax on persons and business entities conducting businesses, occupations and professions within Pike County, Kentucky.

Pike County Ordinance Number 06.30.15.002 requires the completion and filing of **The Pike County Application for Occupational License Tax Questionnaire before the commencement of business.**

Existing businesses must also complete the Occupational License Tax Questionnaire.

Please return the completed form within fifteen (15) days.

On and after July 1, 2015, the Occupational License Tax fee shall be paid in accordance with the Ordinance as follows:

- a) One percent (1%) of the gross wages and compensation paid or payable <u>in Pike</u>

 <u>County</u> for work done or services performed or rendered <u>in Pike County</u> by every resident and nonresident who is an employee;
- b) One percent (1%) of the net profit from business conducted <u>in Pike County</u> by a resident or nonresident business entity;
- c) Any employee/business paying an occupational tax or net profit tax of one percent (1%) or greater to a municipality within Pike County shall receive full credit against the Pike County Occupational License Fee tax and no taxes will be due to Pike County;
- d) Any employee/business paying an occupational tax or net profit tax of less than one percent (1%) to a municipality within Pike County shall pay the difference up to one percent (1%) to Pike County.
