Complete all parts of this application with the required documentation and drop off at the Pike County Courthouse or email to pamela.vanover@ky.gov. Incomplete Applications will not be accepted. Applications will be on a first come first serve basis, and the Pike County Small Business Relief Fund Committee will appropriate available funds among applicants based on percentage of business loss, number of employees, and other methods to be determined. Funds are limited, and grants will be made only as funds are available.

All applications will go before the Pike County Small Business Relief Fund Committee.

To be eligible to apply for this grant, a business must meet the following criteria:

- 1. Physical location within Pike County
- 2. Be open and in operation prior to March 01, 2020
- 3. Employ 50 or fewer Part Time or Full Time employees
- 4. Be a small for-profit business or a small non-profit entity
- 5. Business must be active and operational
- 6. Business must provide documentation showing a cessation or reduction of income due to Coronavirus (COVID-19)
- 7. Grant Applicants are required to provide an IRS W-9 form to the PC Small Business Relief Fund Committee
- 8. If Grant Applicants are registered with Kentucky Secretary of State, then must be in good standing.
- 9. Grant Awards start from \$2,000 and can go up to \$7,500 to be determined by the committee based on economic needs
- 10. Grant Applicants doing business in Pike County or City limits of Pikeville, Elkhorn City and Coal Run Village must be current on their Occupational/Net Profits Fees and Pike County Solid Waste account(s) or other applicable city fees as of March 01, 2020
